



Guidelines for Playing Golf at Spring Meadows (Updated 6/19)

Spring Meadows feels it is important to support public health and safety. We ask your full support in following these guidelines that have incorporated procedures developed specific for golf and set forth by the Maine DECD Office. Following these guidelines will provide you a low risk safe environment to enjoy the game of golf and will minimize the spread of this virus. We look forward to seeing you soon and please – if you are sick or display any symptoms that indicate a cold or sickness or you have or believe you may have been exposed to Covid-19 – do not play golf here or anywhere else. Stay home! Let's keep golf open in Maine for as long as we can during this health crisis - by being responsible and abiding by these guidelines. Thank you!

- Please call or reserve your tee time on-line. Please know that reserving your tee time will not pre-pay for your round. It only reserves your tee time. You can safely make payment when you arrive – where you will self-swipe your own credit card. We will accept cash – but credit card is preferred and provides a safer payment method. Hand sanitizer is always provided to our customers for added protection. If preferred, you can always call the pro shop for advance payment for your round.
- Our tee times are now at 10 minute intervals.
- Currently you will check in at an outside window. We are in the process of adapting our pro shop with plexi-glass that will allow for inside check-in. When this occurs – there will be one entrance and one exit and only 3 golfers will be allowed inside at one time. Signage will provide instruction for inside check-in. For now, all other parts of the building will be closed except for our public restrooms – only accessible at end of building by driving range.
- Our food & beverage area will be offering selected food and beverage items for take-out only. Orders and food pick-up will take place just outside our Players' Lounge. You can also call 207-657-8620 to order food and beverage items.
- Carts are allowed. Immediate family members/same household will be allowed to share a cart. Other golfers will be allowed to share a cart provided each rider wears a face covering for the duration of the round and driver remains the driver for the use of the cart rental.
- We are using pool noodles in our cups at the green to provide a safe way to retrieve your ball without touching the cup or flag stick. Please remember to not touch the flag sticks.
- Our driving range is now open.
- All rakes, ball washers and trash receptacles will be removed from the course.
- Rangers may be used to ensure at least 6 feet spacing between golfers. Please abide by this rule or you may be asked to leave.
- Our carts will be properly sanitized before and after each use. Golfers are asked to return their cart to a designated area following their round and personally dispose of any cart trash in provided receptacles.
- A water re-fill station near the pro shop can now be utilized. We will provide hand-sanitizer for before and after use.
